

Common Products Considered Hazardous for Shipping

CAUTION: ALL Hazardous Materials MUST be declared during the shipping process. Failure to declare hazardous materials may lead to cargo placed on hold or government Penalties

NOTE: Items may be hazardous for shipping under the DOT / IMDG codes depending on chemical make-up or concentration; ALWAYS consult the manufacturers (M)SDS which you can procure from the distributor or point of purchase.

	<p>Aerosol spray cans Cylinders / “tanks”</p> <p>Air conditioning products</p>	<p>Contents under pressure / aerosol, e.g., bug spray, spray paint, cooking spray, starch spray, hair spray; cylinders/tanks containing compressed gases, e.g., propane, oxygen, acetylene, fire extinguishers, CO₂, “canned air”; refrigerant gases, e.g., Freon[®], R134A, R410A</p>
	<p>Alcohol based products</p>	<p>e.g., perfume, rubbing alcohol, gel fuel, hand sanitizer, alcoholic beverages (48-140 proof in packages greater than 250L; 140 proof or more in any package size).</p>
	<p>Automotive products</p>	<p>e.g., motor fuels, fuel injector cleaner, brake cleaner, tire inflators, lead-acid batteries, air bag inflators, seatbelt pre-tensioners, shocks, struts</p>
	<p>Batteries</p>	<p>Medium to large (i.e., non-household variety), wet type, e.g., lead-acid or lead-alkali, or dry type, e.g., Ni-Cd, NiMH, lithium-ion; and battery powered devices, e.g., cordless drills, computer laptops. UPS (battery backup).</p>
	<p>Bleaches & Other Household Cleaners</p>	<p>Some (not all) household bleach is considered hazardous; i.e: <i>Clorox Bleach</i> products; <i>Great Value</i>, <i>White Cloud</i>, <i>HDX</i>, <i>Style Select</i>, <i>Choralex</i> and <i>Cloralen Aromas Floral Bleaches</i>; and <i>Comet Cleaner with Bleach</i> (List not all inclusive) Other household products may contain bleach OR be considered hazardous due to chemical content; i.e. some Bowl Cleaners, Ammonia cleaner, etc.</p>
	<p>Explosives</p>	<p>e.g., ammunitions, small arms cartridges, flares, fireworks.</p>
	<p>Industrial & agriculture material Pesticides</p>	<p>e.g., adhesives, asphalt, MEKP, fertilizers (≥45% ammonium nitrate). i.e., herbicides, fungicides, insecticides, bactericides</p>
	<p>Lighters & matches</p>	<p>Butane “Bic” style lighters; stick and book matches; and butane Stick lighters used for grills and candles are considered lighters.</p>
	<p>Motorized vehicles or equipment</p>	<p>e.g., vehicles, engines, generators, lawnmowers & trimmers.</p>
	<p>Office supplies</p>	<p>e.g., “canned air”, printing inks, hand sanitizers, Liquid Paper[®], UPS (battery backup).</p>
	<p>Paint related materials</p>	<p>e.g., oil-based paints, primers, lacquers, stains, thinners, mineral spirits</p>
	<p>Pool products:</p>	<p>e.g., chlorinating or corrosive pH control products, Hydrochloric acid</p>
